BUDGET/FINANCES:

- The PTO has a balance of \$3800.00. \$435 which was profits obtained from the Pizza Lunch in January and \$365 in February. CYO generated \$400 and the PTO paid out \$500 in gym fees and \$350 to the parish for kitchen supplies.
- E-scrip- 29 people have registered and \$92 has been generated since January 2010. Family and friends were encouraged to register.
- Brown Bear Car Wash fundraiser cost us \$2 per ticket to purchase and we will purchase \$200 worth and sell them for \$6 a piece. It takes 2 weeks to get order processed and we can order more tickets if needed.
